



PERC NATIONAL AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN RESEARCH COLLABORATION GUIDELINES

The **PERC National Award for Excellence in Research Collaboration** replaces the Spirit of PERC Award in 2025. It is awarded annually to recognize individuals within the PERC network who embody our values, excel in collaboration, and demonstrate a longstanding dedication to enhancing pediatric emergency medicine care through research.

SELECTION CRITERIA & ELIGIBILITY

The PERC National Award for Excellence in Research Collaboration honors individuals within the PERC Network who exemplify its core values and demonstrate exceptional teamwork. This award highlights the commitment to advancing pediatric emergency medicine research through demonstrated longstanding contributions. This award aims to foster a culture of appreciation, celebrating outstanding performance and commitment within the PERC network.

Eligible candidates include research coordinators, program managers, research assistants, nurses, and other key team members involved in research, excluding principal investigators. By recognizing remarkable dedication and collaborative spirit, the award promotes a culture of acknowledgment and celebrates those who significantly impact the field within the PERC Network.

NOMINATION PROCESS

Nominations will be sought every year from the PERC membership. Nominations will be considered complete only when the following have been received:

- Nomination letter describing of how the nominee embodies the spirit of PERC and values of our network, excels in collaboration, and demonstrates a longstanding dedication to enhancing pediatric emergency medicine care through research.

DEADLINE AND SELECTION PROCESS

Review and ranking of the candidates will be made by the PERC Awards Sub-Committee.

The nomination deadline is January 10, 2025.
